
Link Windows Files

EXEControl's document storage and retrieval system has been utilized by many clients for several years to scan and associate images to various records throughout the system. The imaging subscreen is available on nearly every record in EXEControl. However, many clients are not aware of the other standard capabilities available through this sub-screen.

A user can link any document, not just a scanned image, to virtually any record in EXEControl. Linking Word documents, Excel spreadsheets, Acrobat PDF's, pictures in any format, etc. can have a wide variety of benefits. In addition to providing links to

these images in the most useful places, this functionality helps organize and catalog your Windows files. By linking documents to system answers, you can use EXEControl's standard cross-referencing and searching logic to help locate Windows documents.

Clients are using this functionality to link product diagrams and images to inventory items. They are also using it to link employee contracts and procedures to answers as well as linking product certifications to item levels.

Outside File Save Audit

EXEControl Global Solutions places great importance on the preservation of client data. The most important measure one can take regarding a business system is to ensure data has been properly backed up. No aspect of a computer system is more important than the protection of your data.

EXEControl Global Solutions has laid out backup procedures, tape rotations, media and hard disk options, off-site storage plans, and tape verification processes. When these steps are followed by you, the client, the risk of losing data is minimized.

However, due to user error and hardware failures, there have been many instances where EXEControl Global Solutions has been called by a client with a system issue, only to find that the saves are incomplete, out of date, or otherwise unusable.

The best way to address those situations is through periodic audits of procedures and saved data. That is why we are offering the following service: On a weekly or monthly interval, the client mails their tape backup to EXEControl Global Solutions, who then loads that save into one of our servers. EGS reads the header information to ensurethat it has recent data, and then performs a complete verification to ensure the entire tape is readable. A note regarding the number of files is also logged to make sure the count looks reasonable for the data being backed up.

Currently, the service is only available for your EXEControl/mvBASE file saves. Saves of Windows and other files should be treated with great importance as well.
